

# SBS GUIDE TO: MADE TO MEASURE SUITING

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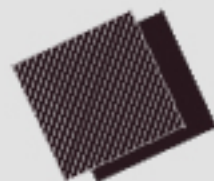


STEP 1.

## CONSULTATION

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Your initial appointment at Stephen Bishop Suiting will begin with a consultation with one of our suiting experts. The amount of choice may seem a little overwhelming, so our role is to work with you to create an idea that can be brought forward into production.



STEP 2.

## FABRIC SELECTION

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Once your unique style has been established, you will have the opportunity to browse our endless array of fabrics. These choices range from lightweight to wool cashmere blends and mulberry silk. After choosing a material and lining, we begin measuring.



STEP 3.

## MEASUREMENTS

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This process takes place in our exclusive 'try on' area. Your consultant will privately fit you with a suit and take your measurements. We then confirm your style requirements; your stitching choice, buttons and detail.



STEP 4.

## TAILORING

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Your suit will then go into production with our master tailors. The process, from placing an order through to store delivery, can take up to six weeks so it is advisable to leave plenty of time before your event to create the perfect suit. Once production is complete we will call to arrange your second appointment.



STEP 5.

## ALTERATIONS

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At your next appointment your suit will be ready to try on. At this point, we will advise on any small adjustments that need to be made, such as trouser length. If any alterations are required, our tailors can easily take care of them. Additional tailoring only takes a couple of days.



STEP 6.

## FINISHED PRODUCT

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After the final alterations have been made, all that is left to do is to try the suit for a final time to confirm the fit. When everything is fitting perfectly, your brand new 'Made to Measure' suit will be ready to take away.
